Minutes of  
Baltimore Yearly Meeting, 1869

At a Yearly Meeting of Friends, held in Baltimore, for the Western Shore of Maryland, Virginia, and the adjacent parts of Pennsylvania, by adjournments from the 16th to the 21st of the 10th month, inclusive, 1869
