with the belief that a union of ~~our~~ ^{the} Committee with
that of Ohio would be attended with beneficial con-
sequence in the future prosecution of the concern
confided to us.
by enabling us through our brethren there, to com-
municate more easily and frequently with the estab-
lishments under our care, we therefore instructed the
deputation which was appointed by us to visit the
Indians at Wampackanilla & Stoney, ^{on} to pass by the
settlement of Friends at Short Creek in the State of
Ohio and endeavour to effect ~~the~~ ^a union of the
Committee of our respective yearly meetings which
was accomplished, and a deputation ^{was} appointed
by our Brethren there to unite in the visit,
who in conjunction with ours performed the service and
from whom the following report was recd.
