Francis T.King was intimately associated with the work of Baltimore Yearly Meeting for more than forty years, giving to it the enthusiasm of his youth, the strength of his manhood and the mature wisdom of his advancing years. In much of the work mentioned hereafter he acted as the loyal servant of the church.

FRANCIS THOMPSON KING was born in Baltimore, 2nd mo. 25th 1819. His father was Joseph King Jr. and was engaged ~~in~~ as a shipping merchant till 1831. His father was English, but on his mother's side he was connected with old Maryland families, many of them Friends.

Francis King was for two years a student at St Mary's College, Baltimore; and afterwards at its opening Haverford School, now Haverford College.
