✓ The following extract from our late Yearly was read.

At a Yearly Meeting of Friends held in Baltimore by adjournments from the 27th of the 10th to the 1st of the 11th month 1828.

The committee appointed at a former sitting reported: that they have provided a house in St Pauls Street for the accommodation of this meeting, and the members of our religious society in this city. It was concluded that hereafter Baltimore Monthly and Quarterly Meetings be held there, and that the members residing in the city here before composing the Preparative Meetings for the Eastern and Western districts, in future constitute one preparative meeting, and meeting for worship also to be held there. The week day meeting to be held on 5th day, and the preparative meeting the week previous to the time of holding the Monthly Meeting.

The Monthly and preparative Meetings to be hereafter distinguished and known by the names of Baltimore Monthly and preparative Meetings for the Eastern ^{and Western} Districts.
