We the committee appointed to adjust and settle the Treasurer's accounts having met and examined the same have agreed to report that the Dues from the different Quarters have all been paid in except \$9.50² from the Miami Quarter and there appears a Balance remaining in the Treasurer's hands of \$1353.35 — We propose the sum of \$400 the ensuing year. — We ~~are~~ free to suggest to the Yearly meeting the propriety of returning a proportion of the yearly meeting Stock to Friends northwest of the Allegany Mountains when the expenditures of the present meeting are ascertained and disposed. — all which we submit to the meeting
