 at a former sitting produced essays & Epistles
 addressed to Philadelphia Rhode Island &
 North Carolina which were read approved &
 directed to be signed

meeting adjourned to
 11 o'clock tomorrow morning

22nd of the 1st mo 1831
 the week according to adjournment meeting
 again assembled

Essays of Epistles were produced
 by the committee to London, New York & Ohio
 yearly meetings, which were read and

after some alteration, approved, and directed
 to be signed and forwarded

The committee
 appointed to take into consideration the
 subject proposed in the Epistle addressed to
 mens meeting from Ohio, reported that after
 a full communication of sentiment they
 had agreed to propose that this meeting
 exceed thereto, which after deliberation was
 united with and the following friends named
 to the service in Martha Bay, Dorothy Hopkins
 Elisabeth Scott, & Hannah Hopkins

Ann Jones & Ruth Cobb were
 appointed to assist the clerks in collecting
 & transcribing the minutes of the present
 year

The representatives being called were
 present as at the first sitting except two who
 were prevented from attending by indisposition

Having been favoured with an evidence
 that the Master has been near enabling us to
 meet the weighty affairs of society we concluded to
 meet again next year if so permitted, on the last
 second day in the 10th month
