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be made strong in supporting the testimonies of truth, when those who now bear the heat and burden of the day, shall be removed from works to rewards.

The necessity of a more diligent attendance of our religious meetings was unaproposely recommended, believing that He who remains to be the Spiritual Teacher of his people, will be with the two or three that are gathered together in his name; and although at seasons they may have to go as with their hands upon their loins crying, "my leanness, my leanness," yet as they are fervently engaged in spirit to wait upon Him, they will realise the fulfillment of his gracious promise, "Fear not little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom," and as we individually endeavour to fulfill the Christian obligations of a highly professing people; we shall avoid all speculations on religious subjects, all jealousies and evil speaking one of another, and be favoured to

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partake of that pure love by which our blessed Lord declared, all men should know his disciples.

Friends were admonished to maintain faithfully our testimony against Slavery and an hireling ministry then adjourned to 3 o'clock to morrow afternoon.

3rd of the moth and 5 of the week - according to adjournment meeting gathered.

The Committee appointed at a former sitting, to address (as way should open) the several yearly meetings in correspondence with us, produced essays which were read, approved, and directed to be signed by the Clerk on behalf of the meeting.

Representatives being called were present as at the first sitting.

Under a sense of the renewed extension of Divine regard, we concluded to meet again at the usual time, next year, if so permitted.
