We believe the time has arrived when these Friends should have an established Meeting and be encouraged to hold the Bull Eagle preparative Meeting— Should Friends of Clearfield become strengthened to hold their Preparative Meeting and Friends of Bellefonte theirs also— these two Meetings will then be able to sustain the late Centre Monthly Meeting— with the prospect of such a conjunction, Friends of Bellefonte were advised to defer their application for a Monthly Meeting until the Friends of Clearfield were ready to cooperate with them in the concern.
