

as circumstances may require. Henry Baldwin, William Procter, John Cripps Junr, Gerard T. Hopkins and George Williamson were appointed for this service. The Clerk was directed to furnish the Committee with a copy of this Minutes, signed on behalf of the Meeting.

Report was at this time made to us, that our Memorial, addressed to the two Houses of Congress, on the subject of the Indians, was duly forwarded, and by the Senate was ordered to be printed. That Memorials of a similar character were also addressed to Congress, not only by our brethren of other Yearly Meetings, but also by people of other religious denominations from various parts of our Country. A law has, notwithstanding, been passed by Congress, very unsatisfactory to the Indians; and which, it is feared, will be attended by serious consequences.

Then adjourned to seven o'clock on seventh day, preceding our ensuing Yearly Meeting.

The following report was presented by the Committee appointed at our last Meeting, relative to the bequest of the late Sarah Zane.

"The Committee appointed in relation to the bequest of the late Sarah Zane Report, that we have given such attention to the subject as the circumstances of the case seemed to require; and that testimony has been offered before the Master in Chancery in Philadelphia, with a view to secure to the Yearly Meeting the benefit of the said bequest. The following is an extract from the Will, which bears date the 24th of the 3rd month 1819.

"I give affectionately to Friends composing Baltimore Yearly Meeting Two hundred Dollars, to be realized in that City, so that the interest, or income thereof be annually paid into their collection towards their Yearly Meeting Stock, if one exists - if not, I Will, if it be the mind of Friends, belonging thereto, the encouragement to establish one."

If the Yearly Meeting should approve of a proposition of claim to the bequest, it is the judgment of the Committee that it will be
