"prosecuting our claim to the bequest of the
"late Sarah Gase. The Clerk was directed
"to furnish that Meeting with a copy of the
"Minute appointing the Trustees.

And the Meeting being informed that the
circumstances of the fund are still under
legal consideration the Committee heretofore
appointed are directed to give such aid to
the Yearly Meeting Committee as may appear
to be requisite.

A copy of a minute was produced
from the late Yearly Meeting, appointing
Joseph Ballance Junr. a member of this
Meeting, in the place of the late Samuel
Hopkins deceased, which was read and
accepted, and his name ordered to be entered
on our list of members.

Then adjourned to the stated time in
the 9th month next.

The Meeting was informed that the bequest
of the late Sarah Gase remains to claim
the care of the Committee appointed to that
service, and that no legal decision had
yet been had in the case.

No further business appearing, adjourned
to seven O'clock in the evening of seventh day
preceding our ensuing Yearly Meeting.

At a Meeting for Sufferings held in Balt^a
according to adjournment the 29th of the 10th
month 1831.

Present 21 Members, also several
brethren from other Yearly Meetings.

It appears that the bequest of the late
Sarah Gase remains to be in train for
legal decision; and that the attention of
the Committee is directed to the case.
