The communication from the Meeting for Sufferings of Indiana (previously meeting), addressed to us, being again brought into view; whilst we unite with our brethren in their concern upon the subject of Slavery, as it now exists in our Country; and, we trust, feel deeply, those responsibilities which rest upon us, in relation to the injuries and to the sufferings of this oppressed people; it is our conclusion to refer the further deliberations thereon to the next Meeting.

No further business appearing, the Meeting adjourns to the stated time in the third month next.
