

First, what number of families, or individuals who have not families, if any, are entirely destitute of the Holy Scriptures.

Second. What number of families, or individuals who have not families, are in possession of the old Testament without the new, or have the New and not the old Testament.

All monthly meetings are desired to forward their Reports to the above enquiries to Nicholas Poppalain, Hugh Balderson, George Williamson and Joseph King Jun^r who are appointed to take charge of the distribution thereof, and report of their care to next Meeting. The Clerk was directed to forward a copy of this minute to each of the monthly meetings within our limits.

The following named friends were appointed to examine into the situation of the Title to the Pasture Lot, belonging to the Yearly Meeting, and report to a future meeting, what steps in their judgment it may be necessary for this Meeting to take in the case, viz. Joseph King Jun^r, Thomas Scott, Isaac Brooks, William Proctor and Hugh Balderson.

Then adjourned to the stated time in the 3rd month next.

The Clerk being absent Hugh Balderson was appointed to serve the present Meeting in that capacity.

The Committee in the case of the bequest of the late Sarah Jane, Reported, some further attention to the subject; they also inform that no Decision has yet been obtained respecting the legality of the bequest, they were continued to the service.

The Committee appointed to take charge of the distribution of the Donation of Fifty copies of the Bible received from Friends of Great Britain, Reported that the information necessary to enable the Committee to make the distribution has not yet been received from all of the Monthly Meetings: they were continued to the subject.

The Committee appointed at last Meeting to make enquiry into the situation of the Title to the Pasture Lot belonging to the Yearly Meeting, not being prepared to report were continued.

A Minute was received from our last yearly Meeting, appointing Jonas Sands a member of this Meeting in the place of Thomas Severing removed beyond the limits of the Yearly Meeting, which was read and accepted, and his name directed to be entered in the list of our Members.
