

At a Meeting for Sufferings held in Baltimore, the 26th day of the 10th Month, 1833.

Present 20 Members, and some Brethren from other Yearly Meetings.

The Committee in the case of the bequest of the late Sarah Lane, reported further attention to the subject, but the case being still undecided, the Committee were continued.

The Committee appointed to take charge of the distribution of 50 Copies of the Bible received from Friends of Great Britain, inform that they have acknowledged the receipt of the Bibles as directed at last Meeting; and having no further progress to report, as regards the distribution, the Committee were continued.

The Committee appointed to make enquiry into the situation of the Tithes to the Pasture Lot belonging to the Yearly Meeting, reported having paid further attention to the subject, and it was concluded to continue the case under the care of the Committee another Year.

Then Adjourned to meet at the stated time in the 3rd Month next.

At a Meeting for Sufferings held in Baltimore the 12th day of the 3rd Month, 1834.

Present 12 Members.

The Committee in the case of the Request of the late Sarah Lane, not having any further change to report since last Meeting, were continued to the service.

The Committee appointed to take charge of 50 Copies of the Bible received from Friends of Great Britain, report that they have made no further distribution since last Meeting: they were again continued.

The Committee appointed to make enquiry into the situation of the Tithes to the Pasture Lot belonging to the Yearly Meeting, made the following Report, Viz:

At the Meeting for Sufferings, the Committee appointed to enquire into the situation of the Tithes to the Pasture Lot belonging to the Yearly Meeting, Report: That the subject has obtained the deliberate consideration of the Committee, and under the circumstances connected therewith, we are generally united in the judgment that it is inexpedient to take any steps in relation to it at present.
