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for correction, for instruction in righteousness; that the
man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto
all good works." And that they are able to make wise
unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."
But thus to experience their efficacy we must come
under the influence of that Spirit from whence they
proceed, that walking in the light, ~~and in the light~~
we may have fellowship one with another, and witness
the Blood of Jesus Christ to cleanse us from all sin.

We tenderly warn our Members and particularly
the young and inexperienced against the evil tendency
of publications which are calculated to weaken their
faith in the fundamental principles of the Christian Religion.

Let us in humility hush to the ground of our Religious
Profession. Let us seek to know the Cross of Christ to
crucify us to the World, and be engaged to follow the
leadings of the Captain of our Salvation. Then shall we
hold fast the form of sound words, be prepared on
suitable occasions, when rightly led thereto, to contend
earnestly for the faith once ~~and~~ delivered to the Saints,
and living in the holy preserving fear of the Lord, be enabled
to adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour in all things.
