"The Committee on the subject of abolishing Lotteries, continued to that service in the 10th Month last, upon conferring together have agreed to report, That the Act to alter and amend the Constitution in reference to the abolition of Lotteries, passed at the previous Session of the Legislature of the State of Maryland, has been confirmed by the General Assembly at their last session. Consequently the Lottery system will cease to exist legally in our State, after the expiration of the present Lottery Grants. Signed on behalf of the Committee,
