The Report of the Committee on Lotteries referred at last Meeting to this for further Consideration was again resumed and it was concluded to continue the Committee who were directed to give such further attention to the subject as may be required and its importance may require.

This Meeting received a Communication from the Meeting for Sufferings of Indiana Yearly Meeting in the 10th Month 1835 ~~stating~~ stating that they had appointed Ephraim Morgan of Cincinnati Agent to receive a donation made by Dr. John W. Lathrop for Indian Civilization and Instruction, which was authorized to be paid into the hands of Samuel Parsons; so far as Indiana was concerned in reference to both appointments.

Baltimore Meeting for Sufferings so far as it was concerned having previously agreed to the appointment of Samuel Parsons, subsequently also consented to the appointment of Ephraim Morgan as the Agent to receive the Money of S. Parsons, and pay it over to the Treasurer of the Committee on Indian Concerns of Indiana Yearly Meeting. But no direction having been given to transmit the information by this Meeting to the Meeting for Sufferings of Ohio, the Clerk is requested to forward a Copy of the forms, as also of this Minute to said Meeting.
