Present 17 Members

We have the acceptable company of our beloved friend Joseph John Curney from England, also several Brethren from neighbouring Yearly Meetings.

The Committee on the bequest of the late Sarah Land are continued.

The Committee on Lotteries made the following report which after being weightily considered was approved, and the Committee were continued; and it was desired that

they might not relax in their efforts to promote the object of their appointment. They are directed to report of their care to this Meeting in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Month next, the names of Richard M. Thomas and John P. Walderston are added to the Committee.

"The Committee on Lotteries report, that during the late session of the Legislature, the Committee of the Senate, to whom our Memorial against the sale of Foreign Lottery tickets was referred, reported a Bill to abolish the sale thereof in this State; but it was rejected on motion to engross it for a third reading. In the House of Delegates the Committee on Lotteries to whom the Memorial was referred, reported that it was inexpedient to legislate at present on the subject: which was adopted by the House two of the Committee entering their dissent to the report on the Journal of the House."
