The Committee appointed in the 10th Mo last
Year "To the end that our Members
and others may have the opportunity of
supplying themselves with copies of Barclay's
Apology, George Fox's Journal & Sewell's History"
have agreed to Report, That we have purchased

47 Copies of Sewell's History

58 " of George Fox's Journal

& 115 " of Barclay's Apology

Making a total of 220 Copies, at an aggregate
cost, including charges of \$181.35 and we have
effected sales, for which payment has been received,
to the amount of \$126.90

We have distributed gratuitously

2 Sewell's History @ \$1.50 = 3.00

6 George Fox's Journal @ 75¢ = 4.50

& 5 Barclay's Apology @ 60¢ = 3.00

\$10.50

We cannot say how many Copies remain unsold
several having been distributed to different
Members of the Committee for sale, which
accounts are not yet closed; but if they were
estimated to be all sold & the money received for
them, we should be able to refund to the
yearly Meeting \$58, the amount we received from
the Treasurer to aid us in our purchases, and also
