

to pay a small balance ¹⁹⁴ we owe, leaving a deficiency only, when all is closed, of about the cost of the Books gratuitously distributed.

We think that the wants of our members have now been pretty fully supplied, and those books which we have on hand unsold will be likely to answer the further demand that may be required for sometime to come, with the exception of George Fox's Journal.

Before the Committee close this report, they desire briefly to advert to the usefulness which it is believed will be derived by disseminating among our members a clear and satisfactory exposition of our principles, as set forth in Robert Barclay's Apology -
