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They continue to pay attention to the concern. They are continued & encouraged to place them in the Public Libraries & elsewhere when such disposition of them may promise to be useful.

Then adjourned to meet at the stated time in the 10th mo next.

At a meeting for Sufferings held in Baltimore the 16th of the 10th month 1852, present 19 members, also several brethren from another Yearly Meeting whose company is acceptable.

The Com^o to procure & circulate certain standard Books made the following report, which was approved of & they are continued.

The Clerk being absent are excused
to the meeting for sufferings.

The Com^o on Books have agreed to report that continued attention has been given to the subject since they last reported under date of 10 mo 18 1851, but the demand has been very small, arising from the circumstance it is supposed of Friends being generally supplied with Friends standard writings. The number of Books on hand at this time is as follows - 6 Copies Senells History

3 Copies Geo Fox's Journal - 13 " Barclays apology

13 " No Cross No Crown - 15 " Anecdotes of Friends

3 " Barclays Catechism - 13 " Penns Rise & Progress & Key

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that the amount of sales since last report has been \$9³². - Apparently to the recommendation of the Mtg for Sufferings under date of 3 mo 12 1852, to place copies of Friends standard works in Public Libraries & elsewhere where they may be likely to be useful - we have accordingly placed one copy each of Senells History, Geo Fox's Journal, & Barclays apology in the Balto City Library, Mercantile Library, Mt Institute & the Smithsonian Institute at Washington. The Books when sent were accompanied with a letter addressed as follows,
