The committee appointed to present the Memorial to our State Legislature made the following report which was acceptable to the Meeting & the committee released. Two of our Number accompanied by Richard M. Jurney, repaired to Annapolis in first Month last, and presented a copy of the Memorial to the Senate which was referred to a Special committee, and also a copy to the House of Delegates which was read, and referred to the Judiciary committee. That we were cordially received by a number of the Members who we had interviews with on the Subject, and that a bill was introduced into, & passed the Senate, which would if it had passed the lower house, but was there rejected, we believe tended very much to curtailing the sale of intoxicating liquors, and that a bill finally passed raising the price of license which we believe is a step towards carrying out our wishes.
