At a called Meeting for Sufferings held 10th month 29th 1865. The following Minute from the Yearly Meeting was received and F. T. King, Dr. C. Thomas and Jesse Tyson to have the revised Book of Discipline put into the printer's hands, to correct the press, to attend to the binding & all services incidental thereto & to draw on the Treasurer of the Yearly Meeting for the expense incurred - the edition not to exceed 500 copies to the Meeting for Sufferings.

At a Yearly Meeting held in Baltimore by adjournments from the 23rd of the 10th month to the 27th of the Same inclusive 1865. The revision of our Book of Discipline as reported to this meeting by the Meeting for Sufferings engaged the serious and careful attention of Men and Women's Yearly Meetings, jointly, during the several Sessions of the Meeting since 4th day Morning inclusive. All verbal & other alterations and the corresponding

facts of the old Discipline were carefully read, considered and compared, also the additions in connection with the articles to which they belong.

After a number of additions and alterations the Yearly Meeting in joint session, united with and adopted the report of the Committee as the Discipline of the Yearly Meeting and our Subordinate Meetings and Members are directed, hereafter, to conform thereto.

Our clerk, were directed to furnish each of the Quarterly Meetings and the Half Year Meeting of Virginia with Copies of this Minute, to be sent down by them to the Subordinate Meetings.

The Discipline as now revised is referred back to the Meeting for Sufferings, to be printed for distribution, and our Treasurer is directed to pay the cost of publication.
