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of the above amount \$6,276⁶⁹ was applied to
the erection of the new Meeting house, now occupied
by the Yearly Meeting which cost with the lot \$46,000
and was paid for, less the above amount by Balbo
Monthly Meetings, leaving in the hands of the Committee
the sum of \$1723³¹ principal and \$320⁸⁹ accrued
interest, in all \$2,044¹⁸ to the credit of the
Yearly Meeting. Signed,
