veyed tho in fact it was intended for the
use and benefit of those Members of the
religious Society of Friends residing in
Charles County - that said heirs at law
are desirous of conveying said land to the
Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends (Orthodox)
that the same may be preserved as a place
of religious Meetings as long as said
Yearly Meeting may require -
Conveys all that piece or parcel of ground
called a part of Howard Brocks' situate
lying and being in the Ninth Election Dis-
trict of Charles County on the public
road leading from Hughesville to Charlotte
Hall and described as follows - Beginning
for the same at a large stone on the afore-
said public road not far from said
Hughesville and running thence East South
(70) yards to a stone on the hill, thence South

one hundred and forty yards by a stone, thence
West South by yard to the aforesaid public
road and thence with said road one hundred
and forty yards to the beginning, con-
taining two acres of land -
