Conveys lot at stile in King George County Va
 near the junction of the Williams and Machodre
 Creeks. as follows:-

Beginning at a stone situated 24 ft. N.E. of a
 large Pear tree near a stone house; thence due
 North 132 ft to a stone - thence due west to
 low water mark in Williams Creek; thence
 commencing again at said stone of beginning
 first a line named, and running thence due
 West 165 ft to low water mark in Williams
 Creek and thence North with said Creek to
 the end of the ebb line on the North side
 of the lot, containing no less of an acre
 of land near a lot in which a meeting
 house has been erected, known as stile place.

In trust for Society of Friends in unity with
 the Annual Yearly Meeting of Friends worshipping

at stile in which a house has been erected
 to be used as a place of meeting and to
 be subject to the discipline and under the con-
 trol of the Baltimore Yearly Meeting of
 Orthodox Friends -

In case the house should at any time be not
 used for a reasonable length of time as a
 place of meeting and worship the deed pro-
 vides that the land shall revert by grant
 to and that Baltimore Yearly Meeting shall
 be compensated for value of building.
