Conveys with general warranty the following property viz All that certain lot or parcel of land situated in the Berlin and Iron Magisterial District in the said County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, Containing by a recent Survey $86/100$ of an acre; more or less and which is bounded and described as follows: beginning on the Berlin and Blackwater bridge road at the Southwest Corner of the Church lot, of which Church the said Trustees are members and for which they are acting, at an iron post buried in the ground, thence North $75^{\circ} 44'$ East 92.75 feet to another iron post buried in the ground, thence North 13° West 545.82 feet to another iron post on an old ditch; thence South $5^{\circ} 2'$ West 142 feet to a marked black gum on the ditch; thence South 1° West 100 feet to a marked Sweet gum, thence South $6^{\circ} 4'$ East 106 feet to a marked white oak, thence South $12^{\circ} 2'$ East 95.70 feet to a marked black gum, thence South $13^{\circ} 2'$ East 123.42 feet to the point of beginning -
