Consideration

Conveys all that certain lot situate in
 Bellefonte, bounded on the East by lot of Hugh
 McConigle, on the West by James D. Harris
 Mill Tract, with a Friends Meeting House
 there erected; beginning at a post on the
 line of said Mill Tract, thence North 45° East
 88½ feet to a post, thence South 25° East 88 ft
 to a post, thence South 40° West 16 ft by the road leading from
 Bellefonte to Harris' Mill to a post,
 thence North 25° West 20 ft to a post, thence
 South 60° West 72 ft to a post on the
 line of said Mill Tract, thence North 25°
 West 102 ft to the place of beginning
 to be held - unto the said Isaac Miller, the
 party of the second part and his heirs according
 to the Course of the Common Law of England
 and his assigns in Trust Nevertheless to and
 for the use and benefit and advantage of the
 Religious Society of the People Called Quakers
 belonging to Centre Monthly Meeting, held

at Bellefonte in perpetual Succession forever

Isaac Miller - in Trust

Conveys all that certain lot or piece of
 ground situate on the Northern border of the
 large tract adjoining a lot of Dr. Daniel
 Robbins on the North, and enclosed by
 a stone wall, occupied and designated as
 place of burial -

unto the said Isaac Miller, the party
 of the second part hereby and his heirs
 according to the Common Law of England
 and his assigns, in Trust Nevertheless
 to and for the use of and benefit and
 advantage of the People Called Quakers
 belonging to Centre Monthly Meeting
 held at Bellefonte, in perpetual suc-
 cession forever -

Appointment of New Trustees -
 On Petition of Eliza M. Thomas & others the
 Court of Common Pleas of Centre County Penna
 by Decree dated May 11th 1901 appointed George
 Valentine Jr. Edmund Blanchard and Joseph
