that friends of Indian Spring Preparative Meeting have for some time past regularly held their Meetings for Worship in accordance with the directions of the Yearly Meeting; and with the concurrence and approbation of the Yearly Meetings committee, who are free to propose: - that they be advised and encouraged to hold their Preparative Meeting in like manner select from those who have joined in the separation; and that the members in unity with us, residing within the District of Columbia and its vicinity who now constitute a Meeting for Worship held by direction and under the sanction of the Yearly Meetings committee, be attached to said Preparative Meeting, and that it be held at the usual time of holding said meeting, alternately at Indian Spring and Washington; to be known and distinguished as heretofore by the name of Indian Spring Preparative Meeting; and that the said preparative Meeting should for the present be united to, and report to Baltimore Monthly Meeting for the Eastern and Western districts instead of Indian Spring Monthly Meeting. That the said preparative Meeting be held at

Indian Spring in the 7th month next: and the Meeting for Worship there and at Washington respectively, in the week of the monthly and preparative Meeting be discontinued.
