Mary Dobbin (formerly Townsend) having had her marriage accomplished contrary to the good order established amongst us, and having been visited by a committee of our Monthly Meeting, manifested no disposition to make satisfaction therefor, or desire to retain her right of membership amongst us we therefore disown her from being a member of our religious society.
