The Committee appointed to deal with Susan Smith on behalf of New Bedford Monthly Meeting reported they had visited her, that she appeared affectionate and tender, but expressed herself entirely satisfied with the steps she had taken, and thus believed that further labour would be unnecessary. Sarah Brooks and Hannah Ballist were appointed to forward the information to that Monthly Meeting.

The three usual Queries with answers from our preparatives have been read; and the following directed to be forwarded to the Quarterly Meeting, by Ann Malinhouse, & Mary Roberson, Hannah Guen, and Anna Procter, who were appointed our representatives.

1st answer. All our meetings for worship and Discipline have been kept up, and generally attended by most of our members on first day Mornings, mid week and afternoon meetings often small; unbecoming behaviour guarded against, the hour of Meetings nearly attended to.

2nd answer. We believe many friends are concerned to maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession,
