At a Monthly Meeting of Women Friends of Phil^a for the Western District held 5th mo 22^d 1833.

The committee appointed to treat with Ann & Rachel Walker, report they have had an interview with Rachel Walker and were united in believing she was not in a suitable disposition to condemn her deviation, and that further labour would be unavailing. Ann Walker being absent from the city their cases are left under the care of the same committee another month.

At a Monthly Meeting of Women Friends of Philadelphia for the Western District held 6th mo 19th 1833.

The Friends to whose care the cases of Ann & Rachel Walker were referred, report they have had an interview with Ann Walker and endeavoured to convince her of the nature of her deviation but she remained insensible thereof, and they believed further labour would be

unavailing.

This meeting directs the clerk to transmit a copy of the foregoing minute to the Monthly Meeting of Women Friends of Baltimore, also one of similar import in the case of Rachel Walker.
