

At Baltimore Monthly Meeting of women friends for the Eastern and western Districts (in unity with the Ancient Yearly Meetings of friends) held the 9th of the 1st Mo 1834

Representatives from Baltimore preparative Meeting present.

The Committee appointed on the request from Indian Spring preparative Meeting were continued to report when ready.

Information was received from Philadelphia Monthly Meeting of Women friends for the Western District, that they had attended to our request relative to Ann and Rachel Walkers testimonies of disownment.

A Certificate was received from New Bedford Monthly Meeting for Ruth Smith dated 11th Mo 28th 1833 also one for Ann Smith bearing the same date which were read and accepted.

Rachel Painter requested a certificate to Birmingham Monthly Meeting, held alternately at Birmingham and West Chester, Pennsylvania. Ann James and Mary Roberson were named to prepare one if no objection appears and produce it to next meeting.

Preparative Meeting informed that Elizabeth Davis (late Slave) has had her marriage accomplished contrary to the established order of our society. Ann Waterhouse and

Parthenia Dukehart were appointed to treat with her and report.

Preparative Meeting informed that Margaret Mapes, Sophia Brooks, Mary Dukehart, Harriet Hull, and Deborah Truwall have individually associated themselves with those who have separated from communion with the ancient society of friends. They have neglected the attendance of our religious meetings and are in connection with meetings not acknowledged by our Yearly Meeting, thus identifying themselves with the seceders and evincing unity with their principles. Clarissa Truwall, Dorothy Brown, and Anna Procter were appointed to treat with them on the occasion and report their case to next meeting.

The friends continued in Sarah Embury's case reported the service performed.

Margaret Cheston, Mary Roberson, Hannah Stapler and Judith Williamson were appointed to offer for the approbation of the meeting friends to serve as clerk and assistant clerk the ensuing year.

Representatives to the late Quarterly Meeting reported their attendance.

The following minute from Philadelphia Monthly Meeting relative to Sarah Harrison was read. Sarah Brooks and Anna Procter were appointed to pay attention to the case and report to next meeting.
