Elizabeth Davis (late Star) having had her Marriage accomplished contrary to the order of our religious society, she has been treated with on that account but not being disposed to condemn her deviation we therefore disown her from membership with us desiring nevertheless that she may become rightly qualified to unite again with us in religious fellowship.

The Committee appointed to visit Susanna Hurdle informed that they had attended there, that she evinced no disposition to condemn her deviation, and also expressed a wish that friends would disown her, they were continued to unite with men friends in preparing a testimony of disownment against her and produce it to next meeting.

The friends appointed to treat with Sarah Harrison, reported they had visited her to satisfaction, and she manifested an earnest desire to retain her right of membership with friends, and with that view had placed an acknowledgement in their possession which they were free to submit to the meeting, and after a time of deliberation thereon the meeting concluded to
