

The Committee appointed produced the following testimony of disownment against Susanna Hurdle which was read approved and directed to be signed, they were continued to hand her a copy thereof and report to next meeting. Susanna Hurdle has so far departed from the good order of our religious society as to associate herself with those who have separated from communion with the ancient society of friends, she has neglected the attendance of our religious meetings and having identified herself with the seceders and evidencing unity with their principles: having been visited and manifesting no disposition to acknowledge her deviation: We therefore disown her from membership with us. Signed on behalf of Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Women friends for the Eastern and Western Districts in unity with the ancient Yearly Meetings of friends held the 10th of 4th Mo 1834.

Our friend Hannah Hopkins a minister in good esteem in a weighty manner informed this meeting that a concern had for some time past rested on her mind to attend the approaching Yearly meeting to be held in Philadelphia which being deliberately considered was united with and she left at liberty to pursue her prospect the Clerk was directed to write with the Clerk of mens meeting in signing a minute expressive thereof.

Baltimore preparative meeting informed that Hannah Marsh, Eliza Marsh, Mary Marsh, and Susanna Pien, have Individually associated themselves with those who have separated from communion with the ancient society of friends, they have neglected the attendance of our religious meetings and are in connection with meetings not acknowledged by our Yearly Meeting! thus identifying themselves with the seceders and evidencing unity with their principles: Ann Waterhouse and Judith W Williamson were appointed to treat with them on the occasion and report.

Then Adjourned
