Eastern and Western Districts in unity with the Ancient
Yearly Meetings of friends held the 10th & 11th Mo 1834

The representatives from Pattemore preparative
meeting present.

The representatives to the late Quarterly
meeting all attended.

The committee continued to furnish
Elizabeth Baker with her testimony of disownment reported
the service performed they were released.

The friends
appointed to treat with Harriet Williamson (late Reed)
reported that they had visited her to satisfaction, and she

evinced an earnest desire to retain her right of membership
with friends, and with that view placed an acknowledgement
in their possession which they feel free to submit to the
meeting; after a time of deliberation thereon the same
friends were continued to furnish Greenpowder Monthly
Meeting with a copy of this minute and the offering and
report.

The committee appointed reported they had
visited Eliza Ann Street (late Malderston) and Elizabeth
Sutton (late Thomas) neither of whom manifested any desire
to retain their right of membership with us, and it being
the judgement of the meeting that they should be disowned
the same friends were continued to unite with men
friends in preparing testimonies of disownment against
them if they should find no cause to forbear and offer
them to next meeting.

The committee appointed to prepare
testimonies of disownment against Margaret Chapin and others
not having them in readiness ^{they} were continued.

The committee
appointed to treat with Ann Whitaker and others produced
the following report, which was considered, and the judgement
of the committee united with, and they were continued in
conjunction with men friends in preparing testimonies of
disownment against them if they should find no cause
to forbear and produce them to next meeting.
