A Certificate for Joseph & Peckham and his wife Hannah & and their Infant Daughter Eliza Olney from Providence Meeting held at Smith Field dated 4th Month 23rd 1834 was read and accepted.

The following report from Burlington Meeting was read and the meeting being of opinion that further care would not be profitable Judith Williamson and Grace Hopkins were appointed to unite with men friends in preparing a testimonial of disavowment against her if they should find no cause to forbear and offer it to next meeting.

In conformity with your request by letter dated 5th Mo 8th 1834 our monthly meeting has given attention to the case of Ruth Little. Agreeably to our appointment we have conferred with her, and finding no cause

At Burlington Monthly Meeting of Women friends held 4th of 9th Mo 1834

The Committee appointed to visit Ruth Little reported that they have had an interview with her in the course of which she manifested an affected and disposition, but informed them, that after serious consideration she could not in truth and sincerely condemn what she had done, and was willing the meeting should be informed that she is satisfied with the step she has taken. The meeting entering into solid consideration of her case, and into feeling with her, from the peculiar circumstances attending it, appointed Rebecca Gullett and Abigail Barker to have another conference with her and if they find no cause for delay, to write to Baltimore Monthly meeting of women friends and give them the requisite information.
