The clerk informed that the minute relative to Rachel Coale and others has been forwarded to Deer Creek Monthly Meeting as directed.

The Committee continued in Rachel Cleavelands case reported that they have visited her to satisfaction, that she manifested a desire to retain her right of membership with friends and with that view placed an acknowledgement in their possession which they feel free to offer to the meeting, and after a time of weighty deliberation thereon, and a sentiment of full unity being expressed therewith, the clerk was directed to transmit a copy of this minute and the offering to Deer Creek Monthly Meeting.

The friends appointed produced the following testimony of disownment against Ruth Little which was read approved and directed to be signed. The same friends were continued to send a copy thereof to Burlington Monthly Meeting, and to request it to furnish her therewith and inform her of her right of appeal.
