Elizabeth Kemp has so far departed from the good order of our religious society as to associate herself with those who have separated from communion with the Ancient Society of friends she has neglected the attendance of our religious meetings and is in connection with meetings not acknowledged by our yearly meeting, thus identifying herself with the seceders and evidencing unity with their principles. She having been visited by a committee of women friends and manifesting no disposition to acknowledge her deviation, we therefore disown her from membership with us.
