Brooks and others produced them a transcript being read they were approved and directed to be signed being as follows; they also produced testimonies of disownment against Hannah Briggs. Henrietta Bentley and others who refused an interview with the Committee one of them being read they were approved and directed to be signed being as follows, they were continued to proceed as the discipline directs in each case respectively and report to next meeting.

Deborah Stabler has so far departed from the good order of our religious society as to associate herself with those who have separated from communion with the ancient

society of friends, she has neglected the attendance of our religious meetings and is in connection with meetings not acknowledged by our Yearly meeting, thus identifying herself with the seceders and evidencing unity with their principles; she having been visited by a committee of Women friends and manifesting no disposition to acknowledge her deviation! We therefore disown her from membership with us.
