We have visited Hester M. Pherson and Hannah Kemney, neither of whom

evinced any disposition to make satisfaction to the meeting. Mary M. Pherson declined an interview with us. It is our opinion that further labour in either of the above cases would be unavailing, which we submit to the meeting.
