to maintain love towards each other becoming our
Christian profession and to discourage tale-bearing
and detraction. When differences appear care is
taken to end them.

3rd Ans. Some friends are careful by example and
precept to educate their children and those under
their care in plainness of speech, deportment and
apparel. To guard them from against reading
pernicious books, and from the corrupt conversation
of the world; also to encourage the frequent reading
