9th Ans. Endeavours are used to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially and to evince to those who will not be reclaimed, the spirit of meekness and love.

10th Ans. None.

12th Ans. Friends endeavour as far as practicable to place their children for tuition under the care of teachers in membership with us.
