

At Baltimore monthly meeting for the Eastern and Western Districts (in unity with the ancient Yearly meetings of Friends) held the 7th of the 6th mo 1858

The 1st, 2^d & 9th Queries were read in this meeting and the following answers directed to be forwarded to the Quarterly Meeting.

1st Answer,

First day morning meetings and those for discipline have been generally attended by the greater part of our members: other meetings often small, no unbecoming behaviour to remark and the hour mostly observed.

Most Friends maintain love towards each other becoming our christian profession, tale-bearing and detraction discouraged, and when differences arise care is taken.

9th Ans.

Endeavours are used to deal with offenders as the discipline directs.

Hannah Stapler, Parthenia Dukehart, Margaret Thornburg and Louisa Landis were appointed our representatives to the Quarterly meeting.

The committee in Elizabeth Ann Gover's case ~~was~~ continued to report when ready.

The committee in the cases of Phebe I Davis and Hadassah J. Moore reported that they had had an opportunity with them, and that

they both expressed themselves satisfied with the meeting they have attended and the committee thought further labour would be unavailing the same friends were continued to unite with men friends in preparing a testimony of disownment if they should find no cause to forbear.

The committee appointed in conjunction with the overseers to visit those who have joined in the seperation from communion and fellowship with our religious society, reported that they had visited Mary Thomas, and that she did not manifest any disposition to withdraw from her present connection and make satisfaction to friends for her deviation, and that they believed further labour in her case would not be useful. They were continued to unite with men friends in preparing a testimony of disownment if they should find no cause to forbear.

Our beloved friends Ruth and Abigail Davis produced at our last meeting, minutes from New Bedford monthly meeting and Sandwich Quarterly meeting, and having completed a visit to the families within the limits of this meeting to the satisfaction of friends, the same having been freely expressed. The clerk was directed to unite with the clerk of men's meeting in signing a copy of this minute.
