1st Answer

apparel, to guard them against reading pernicious books, and from the corrupt conversation of the world, also to encourage the frequent reading of the Holy scriptures.

4th Answer

Care respecting the fourth part of this query and in a good degree careful to observe Moderation and temperance.

5th Answer

We know of no poor amongst us requiring aid and care has been taken to comply with the latter part of the query.

6th Answer

We believe friends are careful respecting the several particulars of this query.

7th Answer

Friends are careful to comply with the requisitions of this query.

8th Answer

Our testimony against slavery is maintained, and we believe that those of the African race in friends families are suitably provided for and that care is taken to instruct them in useful learning.

9th Answer

Evidences have been used to deal with offenders according to the requisitions of the query.
