

At Ballimou Monthly meeting of Women friends for the Eastern & Western districts, (in unity with the Ancient Yearly meetings of friends) held 7th of 11th mo 1839.

Representatives present except one
A minute from A. Addison's Mo. Meeting New Jersey held 10th mo 14. 1839. for Elizth L. Redman expressive of unity with her in a concern to attend Ballimou Yearly Meeting and to visit the families composing Balto. Mo. Meeting was read and she left at liberty to pursue her prospect as truth might open the way; also one for Sarah Nicholson who accompanied her in her visit was acceptably read in this meeting.

The Committee in Elanor Atkinson's case produced a testimony of disownment which was read and directed to be signed being as follows

Elanor Atkinson has so far departed from the good order of our religious Society as to associate herself with those who have separated from communion with the Ancient Society of friends, she has neglected the attendance of our religious meetings and is in communion with meetings not acknowledged by our Yearly Meeting thus identifying herself with the Seceders and evidencing unity with their principles, having been visited and manifesting no disposition to acknowledge her deviation we therefore disown her from membership with us
