May Carpenter has had her marriage accomplished contrary to the order of Society the same friends were appointed to visit her and report

Ann Robinson has gone out in her marriage with her first Cousin Mary Thomas & Hannah Stapler are appointed to prepare a testimony against her

Margaret Jolliffe late Hopkins has had her marriage accomplished contrary to the order of Society to a person not in membership with her. Clarissa Fusell and Margaret Austin were appointed to visit her and report

Hannah Ellicott has joined in membership with another <sup>July 21st</sup> Society and removed to reside in Pennsylvania. Hannah Ann Tyson and Ann Jones are appointed to write to New Garden Mo Meeting and request them to treat with her on our behalf

Marian Fowler, Mary Thomas, Hannah Ann Tyson and ~~Stark~~ <sup>Stark</sup> are appointed to receive suitable friends at their meeting at ~~Camden~~ <sup>Camden</sup> and help with kind regards and ~~kind~~ <sup>kind</sup> regards to all

The Clerk was directed to prepare a minute for Elizabeth Redman's expression of the unity of the meeting with her religious friends in her district
