our preparative meetings were read and  
the following directed to be forwarded  
to the Quarterly Meeting, Hannah Staples  
Hannah Ann Tyson, Margaret Thornburgh  
and Face King were appointed representatives  
by whom was sent \$22.50 towards the  
yearly meeting stock

1<sup>st</sup> Art

All our meetings for worship  
and discipline have been generally  
well attended; no unbecoming behaviour  
to remark and the hour mostly observed

2<sup>d</sup> Art

We believe friends generally  
maintain love towards each other becoming  
our Christian profession. Talebearing and  
detraction discouraged, and we know of no  
differences amongst us

3<sup>d</sup> Art

Some friends are concerned  
to comply with the forepart of the Query  
in the education of their children

and many friends are careful to guard  
them against reading pernicious books  
and to encourage them frequently to read  
the Holy scriptures

4<sup>th</sup> Art

Our testimony against distilled  
spiritous liquors is maintained, and we  
believe friends are mostly clear with regard  
to the latter part of the Query

5<sup>th</sup> Art

No poor amongst us requiring aid  
and the school education of children com-  
ing under the notice of friends has been  
attended to

6<sup>th</sup> Art

Friends <sup>generally</sup> appear to be clear as  
respects the several particulars of the Query

7<sup>th</sup> Art

Friends appear careful to live with-  
in the bounds of their circumstances, and  
to observe punctuality and justice in their  
dealings

8<sup>th</sup> Art

With one exception which is under  
case Friends are careful to bear a testimony  
against slavery, and to provide suitably for  
those of the African race in their families  
and some care is taken to instruct them  
in useful learning
