"At a monthly meeting of women friends of Philadelphia held the 29th & 30th mo. 1841.

The committee separated to the service report they called at the residence of Elizabeth Jackson and Mary T. Clapp, who declined seeing them and refused to accept the Testimonies of disownment. The clerk is directed to transmit to Baltimore monthly meeting of women friends a copy of this minute and sign it on behalf of the meeting"

The committee appointed to nominate two friends to serve the meeting as clerks the ensuing year proposed Hannah Talbot as clerk and Marianne Fowler as assistant clerk

with which the meeting united Hannah Talbot not being present her appointment is left to next meeting

Margaret Balderson Tace & Eliza Debrah Packer, and Hannah Staples, were named to collect for the yearly meeting stock & report to next meeting.

Epistles from Ohio & Virginia yearly meetings were acceptably read.
