reported the sum of \$22.56 to which was directed to
be paid to Margaret Thornburgh she having been
appointed Treasurer in place of our deceased friend
Ann Waterhouse. Elizabeth Hopkins was added
to the committee who have charge of such
as may require the aid of the monthly meeting

A communication was received
from Misizginawa Monthly meeting with information
that the testimony of disownment issued in 4^{mo} 1840
by this meeting against Rachel T. Carr had been delivered
to her

William W. Handy and Mary Ann Poultney opened
their intentions ^{of marriage} with each other for the approbation of the
meeting. Mary Ann Fowler and Elizabeth Robertson
were appointed to make the usual enquiry and report

Abner Hald attended the meeting
with a minute from Middleton monthly meeting
Ohio endorsed by Salem Quarterly meeting setting
him at liberty to visit the Yearly Meeting of North
Carolina and the meetings constituting it also those
constituting Baltimore & a part of Virginia Yearly
meetings his gospel services were acceptable.
The clerk was directed to write with the clerk
of mens meeting in signing a minute
expressive thereof
