Two Representatives present—

The 1st 2^d and 3^d queries were read with their answers, and the following adopted and directed to be forwarded to the Quarterly Meeting, to attend which we appoint Sarah Janney, Sarah Savage, Margaret Baldeston, and Hannah Salters as our Representatives.

1st Answer All our meetings for worship and discipline have been attended, with the exception of the small meeting held at Indian Spring. First day afternoon meetings are frequently small; unbecoming behavior generally avoided, and the hour of meeting mostly observed.

2^d Answer Many friends are concerned for the maintenance of that love which becomes our Christian profession. Slandering and detraction we believe are mostly discouraged in apparent differences among us.

3^d Answer Care is taken to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially and to win to those who will not be reclaimed the spirit of meekness and love before they are dismissed.

A certificate for our esteemed friend David Dudley from St Albans monthly meeting Maine, also a minute for David Kelly from Sandwich monthly meeting Mass, were acceptably read in this meeting.

The committee in Ann Green's case not being in readiness to report on account of the indisposition of one of the committee are continued.

The committee in clerks prepared the name of Elizabeth S. King for clerk, and Rachel Bucks for assistant, which was voted with, and they are appointed to those stations.

Hannah Bryan having requested to be received into membership with our Religious Society, Hannah Salters and Jacey E. King were appointed to visit her and report.

The friends appointed to make the necessary inquiry in relation to Margaret Hopkins' proceeding in marriage with Miles White, report they found nothing to prevent said marriage. The same friends are continued to attend it and report next month.

A certificate granted Priscilla Webster to Deer Creek Monthly Meeting was returned. She having removed to Baltimore to reside.
